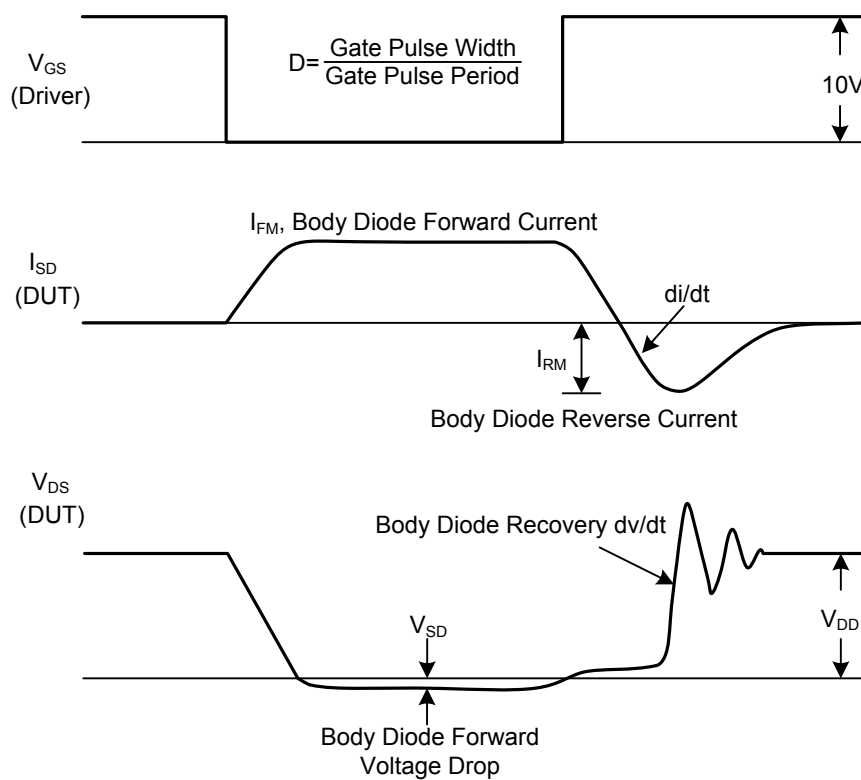

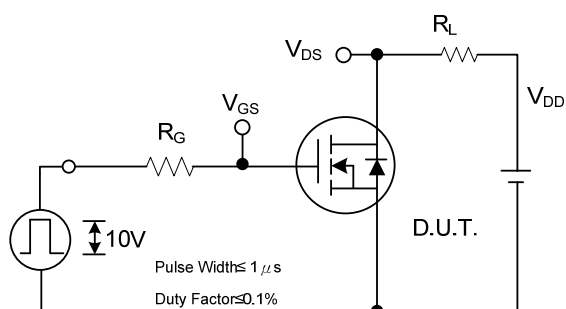


Peak Diode Recovery  $dv/dt$  Test Circuit

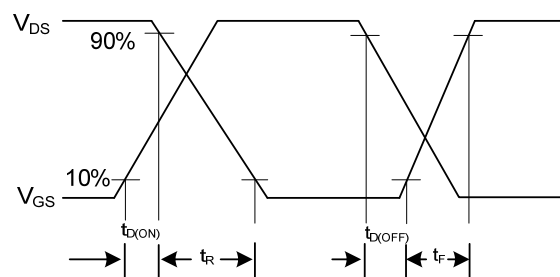


Peak Diode Recovery  $dv/dt$  Waveforms

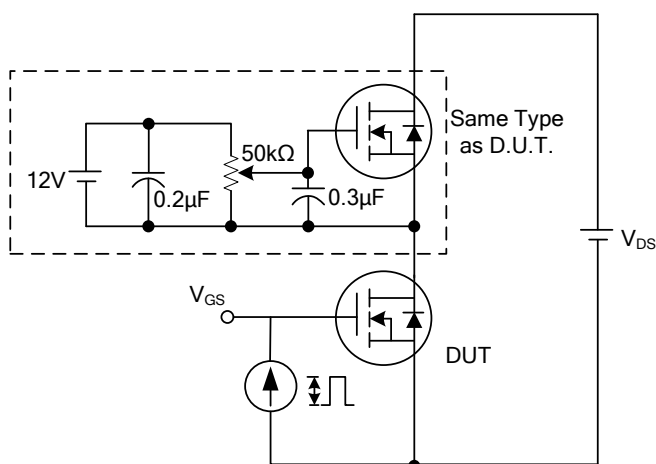

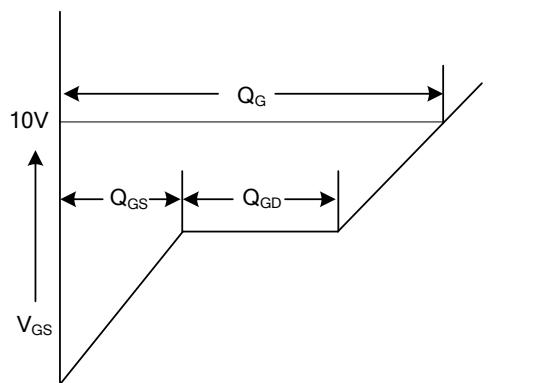
Switching Test Circuit



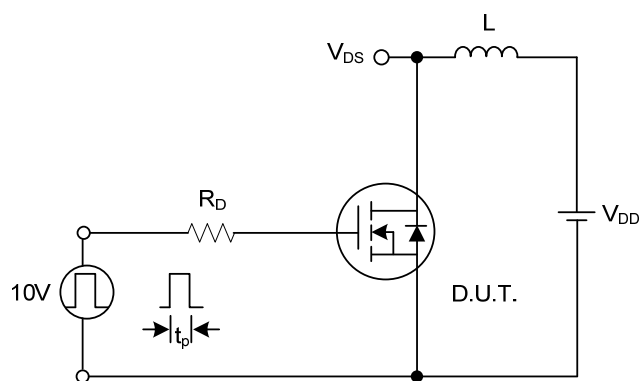
Switching Waveforms



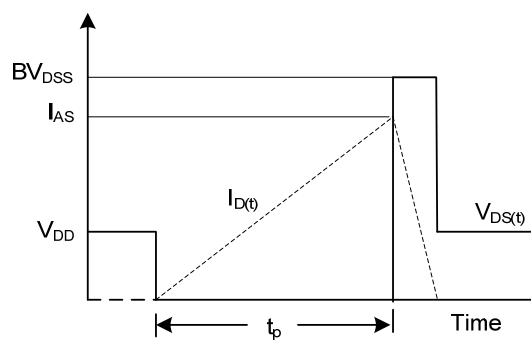
Gate Charge Test Circuit
